## History of JRDR

- 1966 A pilot survey (the former JRDR survey) was conducted by Dr. Odaka.
- 1968 The first JRDR survey was conducted with only facility survey. (The number of total dialysis patients was 251.)
- 1971-'72 A pilot survey for each patient data was conducted.
- 1977 A patient survey was conducted regularly. Only a cross-sectional analysis was conducted.
- 1983 A cohort system for all dialysis patients was established. The main survey items were the basic demographic factors of dialysis patients.
- 1988 Survey items were extended to the comorbidity, dialysis prescription, medications, and so on of dialysis patients.
- 1992 The first analysis of the risk factors of mortality was performed, including dialysis dose (Kt/V) and mortality.

1994 Electronic data collection in a floppy disk was started.

- 2000 The operating system of the JRDR was downsized from a mainframe computer to a personal computer.
- 2001 The first time annual dialysis reports were provided, in a CDR containing PDF files.
- 2004 The first English version of the Annual Dialysis Data Report (ADR) of the JRDR was published on TAD.
- 2006 The research competition using JRDR data began. Data cleaning of the JRDR was initiated for research use.
- 2015 Data cleaning of the JRDR was accomplished. A total anonymization system was installed into the JRDR survey system.
- 2017 Publication of the English version the ADR of the JRDR was transferred to a new JSDT official journal, *Renal Replacement Therapy*.

The Web-based Analysis of Dialysis Data Archives (WADDA) system was launched.
